

## Notice of Construction Activity

Please be advised, weather permitting, Kantrax Contractors Ltd. will begin roadway and trail asphalt overlays. Please remove your vehicles/RV's prior to 7am, for each stage of construction that affects your area. Road Closure Barricades and No Parking Signs will be placed in restricted areas the night before. Temporary trail closures will be required so please be aware.

All dates are approximate and weather dependant. We thank you for your patience during construction and renewal of your roadway. We at Kantrax regard safety as a priority and would appreciate your assistance in informing your customers that this construction site will have many dangers and remind them to stay clear from the construction area and use the open sidewalks only.

Kantrax Contractors Ltd. employees and subcontractors are all required to abide by Company Safety Policies and Occupational Health and Safety Regulations to ensure safety to the public and themselves, however, children as well can be attracted to construction sites and equipment. We request your assistance in informing them of the dangers and reminding them to stay away from construction zones. Thank you for your assistance in maintaining safety on our work sites.

During construction, if you require access for any deliveries or drop offs, please contact Mark Trenchard and we will be happy to arrange something that works.

## **Covid-19 Mitigation**

Kantrax Contractors Ltd. is following current public health orders from Alberta Health Services in regards to additional requirements to mitigate the spread of Covid-19. Signage will be onsite at all entrances to the walkways of our site indicating the current requirements in effect for the worksite. We ask that all businesses and their staff stay updated with public health orders as available from Alberta Health Services.

Currently, we require physical distancing of 2.0 meters or 6 feet between all personnel when personal protective equipment is not worn. Please provide this safe working distance from our staff and inform your customers to do the same.

## **Expect the Following Construction Stages:**

- 1. **Roadway Base Repair June 14-15 –** 5<sup>th</sup> street and Marine Drive. Please note that 5<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed until this repair is completed. Marine Drive will have one lane access only. Flag persons will be onsite to direct traffic until the area is passable.
- 2. **Trail Overlays June 16-17 –** In preparation for this stage, the trails will remain closed. Please respect the closure and stay clear of the area until completion. Kantrax will start at the 1<sup>st</sup> street trail and work westwards.
- 3. **Asphalt Milling and Overlay June 18-24** In preparation for this stage, the road will remain closed. We will be using large equipment including road pavers and compactors to tack and asphalt. Please note that the tack can be messy. Please keep off with vehicles and foot traffic until it has time to cure.

**Phase 1** – June 18-19 – 1<sup>st</sup> Street, 2<sup>nd</sup> Street and Marine Drive Between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Streets.

**Phase 2** – June 21-22 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, 4<sup>th</sup> Street and Marine Drive Between 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Streets.

**Phase 3** – June 23-24 – 5<sup>th</sup> Street, 6<sup>th</sup> Street and Marine Drive Between 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Streets.

4. **Driveway Tie-ins and Landscaping –** Following all preceding construction stages, asphalt, gravel and topsoil/seed will be installed June 25-30. The road will not be closed during this stage, but rather temporary lane closures. Flaggers will be onsite to direct traffic until completion.
