



## LARGE ITEM GUIDELINES

Leave items at the curbside by 7:00 a.m. and we will haul them away for you. Items may be collected by different trucks.

### Special notes:

- Houses with back alleys must have large items put out at **front** of your property for collection.
- Put a note on items (basketball and hockey nets, lawn mowers, wheelbarrows, rain barrels, bicycles etc.) to help identify it as being out for pick up.
- All items must be less than 6 feet by 3 feet (1.8 metres x 0.9 metres) and weigh less than 200 lbs. (90 kg).

Some examples of acceptable items for collection include:

Different trucks collect different items, and where possible, items are sent to be recycled.

Items which are **not acceptable** for collection include:

• Televisions	• Tires
• Stereos	• Propane tanks
• Computers (monitor, towers, keyboards etc.)	• Fridges
• Desktop printer	• Freezers
• Car parts	• Air conditioners
• Snowmobiles	• Items larger than 1.8 metres (6 ft) in length
• Assembled swing sets	• Items weighing more than 200 lbs.

Various electronics not collected may be e-cycled.
