

#### **OVERVIEW**

As of 2021, the Alberta
Government has new
requirements for placing docks
and mooring structures in
Alberta Lakes. This brochure
outlines the requirements and
process for residents to place a
temporary, seasonal dock for
personal recreational use.

## WHAT YOU NEED TO

- 1. Examine the 'Moorage Allowance Infographic' located in this brochure.
- 2. Assess if your moorage plan is entirely consistent with the dimensions in that 'infographic'
- 3. If your property is on the water and your dock, lift and other structures meet all the standards in that graphic, no further action is required.

- 4. If your dock or other structures deviate from the 'infographic' you require to apply for Municipal approval and provincial government "Temporary Field Authorization" (TFA)

- 5. If your dock or other structures are to be placed in the water adjacent to municipal property (parks and reserves), one person needs to obtain approval from the Summer Village.

- 6. All equipment in front of Municipal property once approved, must be clearly marked as per ownership.

Municipal approval.

Unregistered or unmarked equipment will be removed at the owners cost.

### OBTAINING MUNICIPAL APPROVAL:

### OBTAINING A PROVINCIAL TFA:

 If you require a TFA you will need to obtain Municipal approval first, followed by a provincial ID and then apply for a TFA.
